
Using a Task Plan

A task plan is a way to structure an activity with your child. The task plan breaks up the activity into smaller parts which are more manageable for children to achieve. It also helps to structure an activity so the child knows exactly what to do. Task plans can come in lots of different formats. You can use words or pictures to help your child compete their activity. Below is an example of how a task plan may be used to help your child complete an activity at home



Remember! Task plans are there to help you and your child manage an activity. They can be as detailed or basic as you want to make them. You can use a template or write them out on a piece of paper. The purpose of them is to give clear instructions to your child about how to complete a task they have been set.
