The pupils and staff are identifying acts of kindness throughout the school.

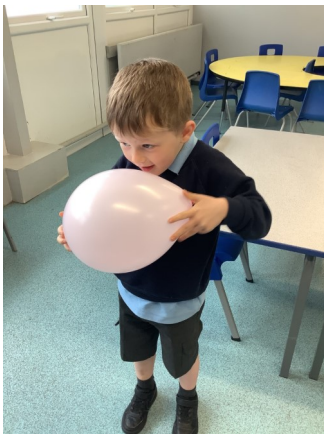
