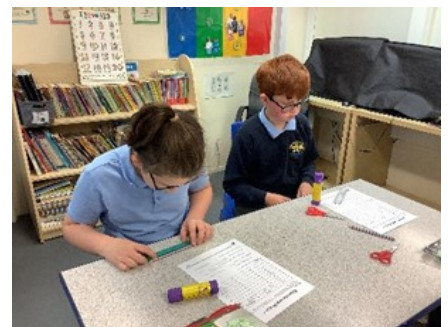
# CLASS OF THE WEEK
