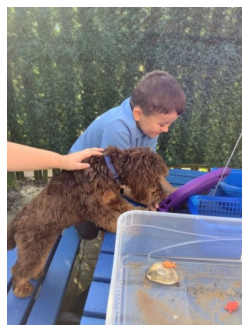


## Our celebrations this week: Friday 15th September 2023

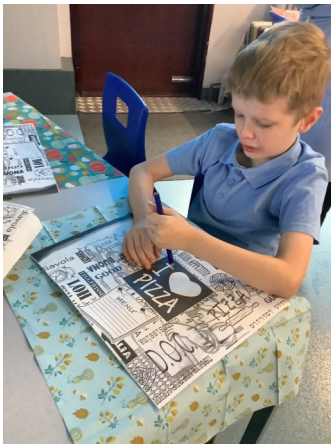
