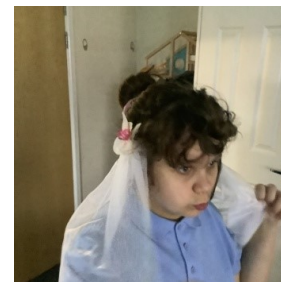
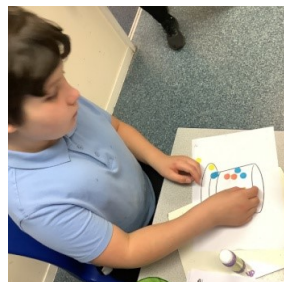
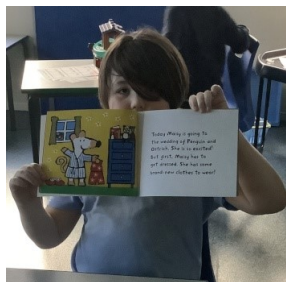


Our celebrations this week: Friday 24th November 2023
