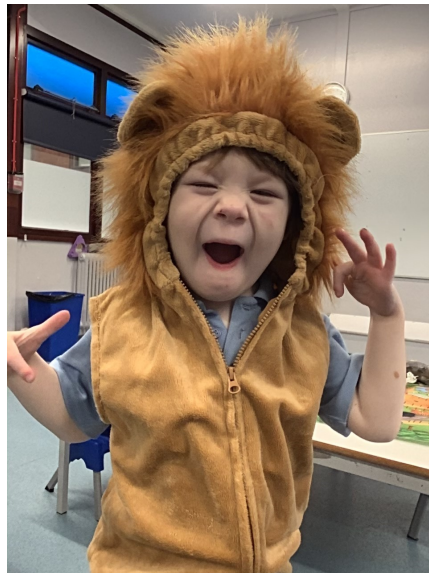
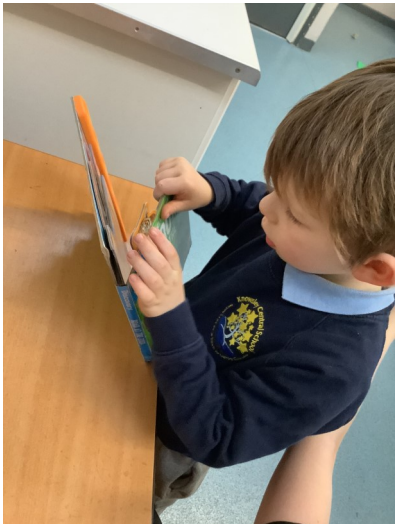
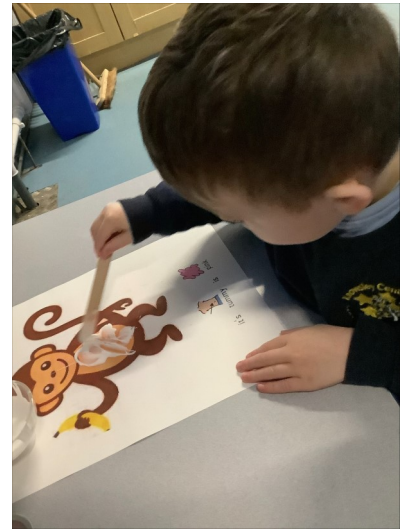
- This week in class Willow, we celebrated Lillie's 8th birthday and explored different activities in the library.
