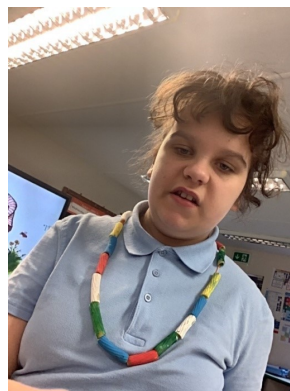

Our celebrations this week: Friday 2nd February 2024

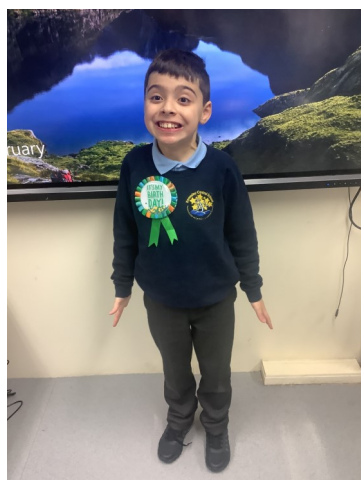
