# CLASS OF THE WEEK

## MULBERRY

Our topic this half-term in class Mulberry is "Brilliant Britain". The children have enjoyed the story "Scouse Mouse Has Lost His House" by Nic and Sean Ryan. They've used commenting boards confidently to name landmarks of Liverpool. They have also learnt how to use interactive 'Chatta' programme to re-tell the adventures of the Scouse Mouse. In Maths we've explored patterns and 3D shapes, engaged in number rhymes sessions and learnt about ordinal numbers. In Music we've learnt about classical and modern British music, and in Art we've become familiar with the artwork of the famous modern British artists: Anthony Gormley and Banksy. We have created art work inspired by their works. In History we have learnt about kings, queens and castles, and engaged in role-play activities.
